

WHAT CAN I DO IF I SUSPECT THAT MY CHILD HAS CONTRACTED THE COVID?

SIMPLIFIED PROTOCOL

A - SYMPTOMS THAT TRIGGER THIS PROTOCOL

- Temperature above 37.5 degrees
- Respiratory symptoms (cough, sore throat, cold)
- Severe headache
- Dysentery
- Conjunctivitis
- Anosmia (loss of smell)
- Ageusia (loss of taste)
- Muscle aches
- Dyspnea (difficulty in breathing, wheezing)

PARENTS should contact the pediatrician. If the pediatrician asks, the child will be accompanied to the

swab point. The swab can be done at the points indicated by the doctor and dedicated to the school.

If the swab is negative, the child will stay at home until recovery and return to school with the justification on the Web Booklet. (Write: health reasons not related to Covid_19)

If the test is positive, the family notifies the coordinator of the module / class (write to the institutional email) and the secretariat at the following address BSIC89200C@ISTRUZIONE.IT

The child follows the procedure indicated by the doctor (isolation and / or quarantine pending the next swab).

THE RETURN TO SCHOOL of children in isolation / quarantine:

To return to school, the pediatrician's certificate of "safe re-admission to the community" is required, which must be

delivered to the school secretariat,
notifying the teacher of the first hour in
the diary.

Only with this certificate can the
student return to school with the
justification on the web booklet.
